



Community Speedwatch in Standlake

Following the **GO LIVE** date for West Oxfordshire, our Speedwatch Co-ordinator Robert Maxwell has registered the group and has successfully completed the online training. Various operating sites have been identified around the village which have been submitted to Thames Valley Police for final approval which is expected shortly. Thanks must be extended to Robert for all the work he is putting in to help make our village a safer place.



The group has 17 volunteers so far. During a 20 minute training session on Abingdon Road recently a number of vehicles were observed doing in excess of 40mph in the 30mph limit which emphasises the importance of Speedwatch. There is also a lot of positive feedback about the activity of the group which is encouraging. Other traffic calming and speed awareness measures are also being investigated.

More volunteers **are still** required! The more teams that can be mobilised around the village on different days and different times the better.
